Young People's Home-Share Philosophy Statement

We Believe that:

- ◆ Young people want to contribute to and be part of their community.
- ◆ There are a range of housing options for young people that are no longer able to live with their families.
- ◆ Young people's needs are often not well met by these existing options.
- ◆ Young people are more likely to maintain connection to their family, school, peers and existing supports if they can maintain connection to their local community therefore leading to increased wellbeing.
- ◆ Many of the young people that we support do not need or want the level of support offered in other supported housing.

- ◆ Many of the young people that we support do not yet have the skills to successfully negotiate shared accommodation, nor do they wish to live on their own.
- ◆ Supportive relationships with housemates, neighbours, and local business owners will assist young people to feel connected, welcome and valued in their local communities.
- ◆ The supportive relationships built and maintained between the young householders and the local community will also foster possible relationships, leading to employment, friendship, exposure to new ideas and opportunities, a sense of value and belonging.
- ◆ We have the resources (skills, bricks and mortar, experience) to support this project.
